As spokesman for our local community I wish to express our joy in being able to collaborate in the Amatongas missionary project. We are touched by your understanding and interest as we begin our educational mission in favor of the young in the region of Amatongas.

Concerning vocation ministry, we wish to work with the youth according to our charism while at the same time valuing other vocations. In keeping with our agreement with our Bishop here, we commit ourselves to not inviting young people to begin initial formation before four years of presence in the country. This is very much clear to us and normal.

The construction of the residence is going very well. Within two weeks at the most, the building contractor will have accomplished half of the work within the set deadline. The roof is completed, the water system for the toilets, showers and sinks is installed; the windows, doors and furniture for the rooms are ready to be painted. Therefore, everything is running according to plans. In the next few weeks the Brothers will purchase the materials to paint the inside of the residence.



This Sunday (June 19) we will be eight around the dinner table : all members of our Amatonga community, two young volunteers from the United States, Brother Herbert Mangove, Provincial of the Province of ESA and a confrere who will accompany Brother Fabian Jonge, the fourth member of our community.

I wish to thank you for your attention and generosity in our regard. We remain united with the members of the General Council and with the Institute as we sing and pray *Ametur Cor Jesu*.
